

# GAMERS.BET PLAYER PROTECTION POLICY

## 1. Platform Model

Gamers.bet provides infrastructure enabling peer-to-peer, skill-based competitive gameplay within third-party video games.

Gamers.bet:

- Does not act as the house.
- Does not set odds or betting lines.
- Does not compete against users.
- Does not custody pooled player funds.
- Does not trigger payment rails at the moment of gameplay.

Users compete solely against other players in games of skill. Entry fees are typically nominal (generally \$2–\$20 per match).

Funds used for entry are drawn from a user's pre-funded wallet balance and programmatically allocated to a dedicated, single-use event wallet on the blockchain specific to that individual match. Event wallets are isolated from all other competitions, do not commingle funds across matches, and are fully distributed at match conclusion in accordance with predefined payout logic.

## 2. Age and Identity Verification

All users must complete identity verification prior to enabling wallet functionality and participating in real-money competitions.

Participation is restricted to users who meet the minimum age requirements applicable in their jurisdiction under governing law.

### **3. Jurisdictional Compliance**

Gamers.bet enforces jurisdictional controls in accordance with its standalone Geolocation and Jurisdictional Compliance Policy.

Users may only participate from permitted jurisdictions. Location checks occur at key wallet transmittal events.

---

### **4. User-Controlled Participation**

Gamers.bet does not provide credit, betting lines, or house-funded wagering pools.

Certain competitions may include promotional or sponsor-funded prize pool enhancements. Such sponsor contributions are disclosed in advance and do not alter the peer-to-peer, skill-based structure of the competition.

Participation is entirely voluntary and self-managed by the user.

Users may close their account at any time by contacting support. Account closure requests are processed promptly.

### **5. Fair Competition Standards**

All real-money competitions are conducted within games that provide equal competitive conditions to all participants.

Prior to enabling real-money gameplay, Gamers.bet establishes and communicates technical and competition standards that participating game publishers must adhere to. These standards are reviewed and validated before a real-money game mode is made publicly available.

Gamers.bet ensures that:

- Competitions operate under predefined rules and objective performance metrics.
- All participants compete under equal gameplay conditions.
- Gameplay mechanics are not modified in a manner that disadvantages any participant.

- Match outcomes are determined solely by player skill and in-game performance data.

Real-money activation of any game mode occurs only after these standards are confirmed.

## 6. Fee Transparency

Before entering a competition, users are clearly shown:

- Entry fee
- Prize pool amount
- Applicable commission (rake)
- Payout structure

Users must affirmatively confirm participation before funds are committed.

---

## 7. Payout Eligibility and Qualification

Only participants who have satisfied the disclosed entry requirements for a specific competition are eligible to receive a payout from that competition's prize pool. Where an entry fee is required, only participants who have paid the entry fee and contributed to the applicable prize pool are eligible for payout.

In certain game formats, all players may compete together on a unified leaderboard while only a subset of participants elect to pay an entry fee. In such cases, only players who paid the entry fee are ranked against one another for payout purposes. Participants who did not pay an entry fee are not eligible to receive a payout, even if their overall leaderboard position exceeds that of paying participants.

Sponsor-funded prize pool enhancements, where applicable, are distributed only to participants who meet the disclosed eligibility criteria and maintain a verified Gamers.bet account.

Eligibility rules are disclosed prior to participation.

## 8. Risk Disclosure

Gamers.bet clearly discloses that:

- Participation involves financial risk.
- Losses are possible.
- Users should only participate with discretionary funds.
- Loss of internet connectivity, device malfunction, or external technical interruption during gameplay may result in forfeiture of an entry fee.

Users acknowledge these risks prior to participation.

## 9. Responsible Gaming and Player Protection Tools

Gamers.bet is committed to promoting responsible participation in skill-based competitions and providing users with tools to manage their activity on the platform.

### **Voluntary Self-Exclusion**

Users may request temporary or permanent self-exclusion from real-money competitions at any time by contacting Gamers.bet support. Upon activation of a self-exclusion request, the user's account will be restricted from participating in real-money competitions for the duration of the exclusion period.

### **Participation and Spending Controls**

Gamers.bet provides mechanisms that allow users to manage their level of participation. These may include:

- Entry fee participation limits
- Session or participation limits
- Voluntary cooling-off periods
- Account suspension upon user request

These controls are intended to allow users to proactively manage their activity levels.

### **Deposit Controls**

Because Gamers.bet does not custody fiat currency and relies on a regulated payment provider for wallet funding, deposit limits may also be enforced through the payment partner's systems and compliance controls. Users may voluntarily establish daily or weekly participation or spending limits.

### **Problem Gaming Resources**

Gamers.bet encourages responsible participation and provides access to information regarding problem gaming assistance. Users who believe they may be experiencing harmful gaming behavior are encouraged to seek assistance from professional support organizations, including:

## **10. Customer Support and Platform Oversight**

Gamers.bet provides customer support for:

- Account-related inquiries
- Wallet and transaction inquiries
- Technical access issues related to the Gamers.bet platform
- Account closure requests

Gameplay-related disputes, performance issues, or in-game technical matters are managed by the respective game publisher, as gameplay occurs within third-party game environments.

Competition settlement is based on objective gameplay performance data received from the game environment and is processed in accordance with predefined payout logic.

Gamers.bet reserves the right to suspend or disable real-money gameplay functionality within any participating game mode if necessary to maintain platform integrity, regulatory compliance, technical stability, or fair competition standards.
