

Gamers.bet Privacy Policy

Notice: This Privacy Policy describes how Gamers.bet Inc. (“Gamers.bet,” “we,” “us,” or “our”) collects, uses, shares, and protects personal information in connection with the Gamers.bet platform, including our websites, applications, APIs, SDKs, and related services (collectively, the “Platform”). This Privacy Policy is provided in draft form for regulatory, compliance, and payment provider review purposes and is subject to final legal review and approval prior to public launch.

1. Overview

Gamers.bet provides infrastructure that enables skill-based, real-money competitive gameplay within third-party games. Gamers.bet does not operate or control gameplay, scoring logic, or player performance and does not offer games of chance or traditional gambling services.

2. Information We Collect

2.1 Information You Provide

We may collect: - Account information (first and last name, email address, username, date of birth) - Wallet-related information (transaction identifiers, balances, settlement data) - Preferences related to privacy, visibility, and social sharing

Identity Verification Data Handling

Identity verification and KYC/AML checks are performed by third-party identity verification providers. Gamers.bet does not directly collect, store, or process raw identity documents, biometric data, or government-issued identification materials.

Gamers.bet stores only the verification outcome (e.g., verified / not verified), associated timestamps, and jurisdictional eligibility status necessary to enforce compliance and access controls. Sensitive identity data remains with the applicable verification provider and is subject to their privacy and security practices.

2.2 Information Collected Automatically

We may collect: - Device and browser information - IP address and approximate location data - Usage data, logs, and event metadata - Fraud prevention and security signals

2.3 Gameplay and Competition Data

We collect limited gameplay-related data necessary to facilitate competitions and settlement, including: - Game identifier and event identifier - Match results and performance metrics submitted by the game - Entry fees, payouts, and settlement timestamps

Gamers.bet does not collect or store raw gameplay footage or detailed in-game telemetry beyond what is required for settlement and compliance.

3. Username Visibility, Anonymity, and Social Sharing

3.1 Platform Username

Each user is assigned or selects a platform username. Gamers.bet does not publicly display users' real names.

3.2 Visibility Controls

Users may configure how their username appears in public or shareable contexts, including: - **Public:** Username visible to anyone - **Followers Only:** Username visible only to users who follow them - **Anonymous:** Username not displayed publicly

There is no approval or acceptance process for followers. Users can see who is following them, but followers do not require approval.

These settings apply to public leaderboards, platform posts, and content shared externally via social media.

3.3 Match Participant Visibility (Non-Anonymous)

When a user participates in a competition, the usernames of all participants are **always visible to other participants in that same event**. This visibility cannot be disabled and is required to ensure competitive integrity, transparency, and dispute prevention.

Match results displayed within participant-only views are **not publicly accessible and are not shareable**, including by participants in that event.

Only game results posted to the Platform's main feed, which may be viewable by all users, are eligible for sharing. User anonymity and visibility settings apply to such shared or public-facing results.

3.4 Social Media Sharing

Gamers.bet does not post or share gameplay results on a user's behalf. Any external sharing of game results occurs only through explicit user action and is governed by the user's selected visibility and anonymity preferences.

4. How We Use Information

We use collected information to: - Provide, operate, and maintain the Platform - Facilitate skill-based competitions and settlement - Verify identity, age, and jurisdiction - Prevent fraud and enforce platform integrity - Comply with legal, regulatory, KYC, and AML obligations - Enforce jurisdictional availability and access restrictions - Improve Platform performance and security - Respond to support inquiries

Gamers.bet does **not**: - Conduct behavioral profiling for responsible gambling or addiction monitoring - Use personal data for targeted advertising or promotional marketing - Sell or rent user data to third parties

5. How We Share Information

5.1 With Game Developers and Publishers

Game developers and publishers receive access only to data related to their own games, including: - Usernames of participants in their games - Match results, outcomes, and settlement data - Aggregated performance metrics

Developers do not receive personal identity information unless required for legal or compliance reasons.

5.2 With Payment and Compliance Partners

We may share limited information with: - Payment processors and wallet infrastructure providers - Identity verification (KYC) providers - Fraud prevention and compliance vendors

Gamers.bet does not transmit or store raw KYC or identity documentation. KYC providers perform identity checks directly and return only verification status and related compliance signals necessary for platform enforcement.

5.3 Legal and Regulatory Disclosure

We may disclose information to regulators, supervisory authorities, or law enforcement when required by law, regulation, subpoena, or legal process.

5.4 Marketing and Advertising

Gamers.bet does not share personal data with marketing partners or advertising networks.

6. Blockchain and Settlement Data

Certain transaction and settlement data may be recorded on public or permissioned blockchains. Blockchain records may be immutable and publicly accessible. Gamers.bet does not control third-party blockchain networks.

7. Data Retention

We retain personal data only as long as necessary to: - Provide the Platform - Comply with legal, regulatory, accounting, and AML obligations - Resolve disputes and enforce agreements

Certain records, including verification status and transaction data, may be retained for extended periods where required by law.

8. Data Security

Gamers.bet implements reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards designed to protect personal information, including encryption in transit (TLS/SSL), access controls, and monitoring. No system is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

In the event of a personal data breach, Gamers.bet will notify affected users and relevant authorities as required by applicable law.

9. International Data Transfers

Information may be processed and stored in jurisdictions outside a user's country of residence, subject to applicable data protection laws.

10. User Rights

Depending on jurisdiction, users may have rights to: - Access personal information - Request a copy of their data (data portability) - Correct inaccurate information - Request deletion of personal data, subject to legal retention requirements - Object to or restrict certain processing activities - Lodge a complaint with a relevant data protection or supervisory authority

Requests may be subject to identity verification.

11. Specialized Compliance Disclosures

11.1 Age Verification

Gamers.bet requires age verification to prevent access by individuals below the minimum legal age in their jurisdiction.

11.2 Responsible Gaming and Self-Exclusion

Gamers.bet does not operate responsible gambling programs, self-exclusion lists, or addiction monitoring systems and does not provide gambling addiction services.

Responsibility for managing participation limits, self-exclusion, or similar controls rests solely with the user. Users are responsible for determining whether participation in skill-based competitions is appropriate for them.

Gamers.bet does not assume responsibility for, and makes no representations regarding, any responsible gaming or self-exclusion programs that may be offered by third-party game developers, publishers, or other platforms.

11.3 Automated Decision-Making

Gamers.bet may use automated systems for fraud detection, security, and compliance purposes. These systems are not used to profile users for gambling behavior or marketing purposes.

12. Children's Privacy

The Platform is not intended for individuals under the minimum legal age required in their jurisdiction. We do not knowingly collect personal data from minors.

13. Contact Information and Accountability
